### Circular Regarding Board Exams – 2022, March

But dear parents, now that they are starting with their exams, next 30 days is going to be crucial for them as well as you too. Lot of mood swings, sadness, enthusiasm, relaxed behaviour, rudeness, etc can be expected from the children.

Please ensure that a very happy and healthy atmosphere and priority is given to the food they consume (avoid outside food/packed food) and studies in the house during his exams.

## Instructions in regards to the Board Exams:

H You are hereby informed that you must drop your child at exam centre (KCP Siddhartha Adarsh School, Kanuru) on all exam days at sharp 9 A.M and pick them up by 12:30 PM.

H Please see that your child wears a neat and pressed regular school uniform along with polished shoes and fit socks on all exam days to the exam centre.

H See that he / she carries unfolded Admit Card in a see through folder to the exam centre.

**PERMITTED ITEMS** (a) Admit Card & School Identity Card / Govt Photo Identity Proof (For PvtCandidates)

(b) Stationery items i.e., Transparent Pouch, Geometry/Pencil Box, Blue/ Royal Blue Ink/ Ball Point/ Gel Pen,

Scale, Writing Pad, Eraser, Analogue Watch, Trans-parent Water Bottles and Hand Sanitizer 50 ml.

(c) Metro Card, Bus Pass.

**BARRED ITEMS** (a) Any stationery item – such as textual material (printed or written), bits of papers, Calculator (Candidates with Learning Disability i.e., Dyscalculia are permitted to use Calculator as per Circular No.CBSE/COORD/2020 dated 20.1.2020), Pen Drives, Calculator, Log Table (shall be provided by the centres),

Electronic Pen/ Scanner, etc.

(b) Any communication device – such as Mobile Phone, Bluetooth, Earphones, Microphone, Pager, Health Band, Camera, etc.

- (c) Other items like Wallet, Goggles, Handbags, pouches, etc.(d) Any eatable item opened or packed, except for diabetic candidates
- (e) Any other item which could be used for unfair means.

(f) Use of above or similar items will be treated under UFM category and will attract punishment as per rules.

- $\stackrel{.}{H}$  See that your child takes solid breakfast at home around 8:00/8.30 am and also carries some little food to the exam centre which can be taken before they get into the exam hall. (Remember that your child has to stay in the exam hall for 3½ hours)
- H See that your child carries Glucose water / ORS / Coconut water in one bottle to the exam hall along with a big water bottle, if he/she is unwell or else a big water bottle from home.
- 1. See that your child attends to the school on all preparatory days without fail. (See the given Schedule for timings)
- 2. Revision on 10/5/22 and 12/5/22 will be from 2.00 pm to 7.30pm
